Overhand Knot - the basis of many knots



Fisherman's Knot – an overhand tied to the othe rope






Figure Eight – an overhand with an extra twist – much easier to untie



Girth Hitch – quick knot to tie to something – quick to untie



Double fisherman's Knot – wrap overhand twice before pushing it through. A strong and secure knot to join two ropes. The "gold standard" of joining–type knots. Figure Eight Knot on a Bight -0 quick way to form a loop – easy to untie.

Munter Hitch Step 1 – 2 - 3 FORMING A MINTER HITCH With TWO CLOCKWISE TWISTS

Munter Hitch – used as a friction knot for belays

SIT SLINGS SEAT HARNESS FROM A SWAMI BELT SUSPENSION POINT OVERHAND KNOT DULFER SEAT DOUBLED SIT SLING SEAT (i) TIE AN OVERHAND KNOT AND (ii) TIE ENDS INTO WAIST WITH PASS ENDS BETWEEN THE **OVERHAND KNOTS AND** LEGS AND AROUND BUTTOCKS THREAD THROUGH FRONT TAPE.
